Around Nordstrasse three interesting parts of the city of Düsseldorf converge: Derendorf, Golzheim and Pempelfort.

NORDSTRASSE (located in Pempelfort) forms a popular meeting point together with its side streets and extension Munster Road (Münsterstraße Derendorf).

The wide sales and service offer not only covers your daily needs. Various branches of known trading companies and many small owner-operated speciality stores offer a great variety and make you want to go shopping without the hustle and bustle of a big city.

GASTRONOMY

The restaurants around Nordstrasse leave little to be desired. There is a wide choice - for example

- international cuisine in a Mediterranean or Asian ambience
- a hearty meal in the local breweries restaurant
- sweet and savoury snacks with coffee or tea
- Or you can opt for a big ice cream in one of the various cosy Ice cream parlours.

Furthermore there are various bakeries and butchers that offer many a specialty for the small and large appetite in the lunch break.

For your after hours enjoyment in the evening there are plenty of restaurants and pubs to relax in.

LOCATION / HOW TO GET THERE

Due to the easy access to public transportation and ample parking in three parking garages, a detour to Nordstrasse is very easy for fair visitors, business travellers, hikers, and also visitors to the city of Dusseldorf.

The distance from the airport is about 8 km from and from the show grounds about 3.5 km and in the inner city about 3 km. The "Altstadt" and "Königsallee" are just a few minutes away by subway.

Use the subway station "NORDSTRASSE" with the subway trains U78 or U79, or you can also use the tram numbers. 701, 707 or 715
